How we use your personal information

Under the Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA 2018), we must have a legal basis for processing your information – in this case, processing personal information is necessary to perform our statutory duties (**'public task'**).

Some of the ways in which we collect and use the information may be through:

- granting and administering authorisations and maintaining registers
- investigating environmental complaints
- undertaking formal enforcement action
- maintaining our own accounts and records

The personal information we collect and use may include the following: name; address, including postcode; email address and telephone number. SEPA is required, by law, to organise and maintain public registers, and make these registers available for public inspection. We do this by collecting and using the personal information that applicants (or their agents) share in their applications. After the application form has been processed, some of the information from the form is added to the public register and becomes available for public inspection. Signatures, personal email addresses, and telephone numbers are not published, unless publication is statutorily required.

There may be occasions when we are required by law to share your personal information with other organisations, e.g., for regulatory reasons, or because doing so is in the general public interest. Any sharing will be carried out lawfully and securely in accordance with the SEPA Data Protection Policy.

Before you apply

Please ensure you have read the guidance fully before completing and submitting your application.

To register as a producer, you'll need to provide:

- details about your business or organisation (this form);
- information about the products you sell in Scotland;
- an operational plan that shows how you'll meet your legal obligations;
- payment (where applicable) (For information on how to make payment, please contact the DRS Team at <u>depositreturn@sepa.org.uk).</u>

You must answer all questions on this form. Failure to answer any question will result in your application being refused.

Further information on writing an operational plan is available in <u>SEPA's Operational plan:</u> guidance for producers.

For producers with an annual turnover of £85,000 or lower, there will be no registration fee; for all other producers, the registration fee will be £365.

The completed application should be returned to <u>depositreturn@sepa.org.uk</u> or Admin Support (Deposit Return Scheme), Scottish Environment Protection Agency, Angus Smith Building, 6 Parklands Avenue, Eurocentral, Holytown, North Lanarkshire, ML1 4WQ.

This form must be received by SEPA within 28 days of you becoming a producer as defined by the Deposit and Return Scheme for Scotland Regulations 2020.

After you apply

You will receive confirmation that we have received your application.

We may need to contact you if we have questions or need more information.

If your application is successful, you will be added to the list of registered producers and your registration details will be sent to you. If your application is refused, you will be told why this decision was made and provided with details of what to do next.
